Today, professional athletes and celebrities are valuable assets. As their careers develop, athletes improve their skills, acquire unique professional skills, start playing against more experienced professionals, which further increases their level. We call this process the “professional self-improvement cycle”.


At the same time, achieving outstanding performance attracts fans, which in turn makes athletes more attractive to advertisers who are willing to pay huge bucks to use the image of an emerging athlete who is already beginning to lead a lifestyle appropriate to the celebrity, thus attracting even more fans. We call this the “celebrity self-promotion cycle”.

Tennis is the heart of the TokenStars project. Our first token, Ace, was launched specifically to help aspiring tennis players achieve greater success in the sport despite limited financial resources.

We signed the first three athletes in 2019. They are **Valeria Olyanovskaya, Jasza Szajrych and Melissa Boyden**. In 2020, 4 more players were added to our portfolio - **Togan Tokach, Aziz Dadabaev, Margarita Andreyuk and Ibragim Urinov**. Thus, our players represent countries such as Poland, Russia, the Netherlands, Uzbekistan and Turkey.

Valeriya Olyanovskaya

After finishing 2019 at the very end of the first thousand players (995th place), Valeriya reached **779th** position by March 2020. The biggest achievement in her career happened in January 2020. Valeriya won **ITF Turkey o3A** in a tournament in Antalya. In the final match, she masterfully defeated (6:0; 6–2) Silvia Njiric (WTA #610).



Jasza Szajrych

Three champion titles. This brilliant result Jasza Szajrych achieved this year. J3 Sobota, J4 Warsaw, J4 Szczecin — these three tournaments were lucky for Jasza. We look forward to new victories in 2021!

In addition, in November, Yasha reached the highest position in his career - 152nd place.

Margarita Andreyuk

Although in 2020, athletes were accompanied by the cancellation of tournaments and even difficulties with training due to the pandemic, Margarita Andreyuk was able to earn the **champion title in Antalya in the J5 category**. Margarita has big plans for the next year and she plans to implement them thanks to the support of TokenStars.

Togan Tokac

This year Togan played hard at ITF tournaments, taking part in 10 of them. As a rule, these were more representative tournaments of the first or third category. Due to this, he increased his rank from **305th to 127th** position just in a half a year. So far, Togan is 16 years old and we are sure that the first victories await him very soon.



Ibragim Urinov and Aziz Dadabaev

These two talented players from Uzbekistan, who, among other things, play together in doubles, were unable to show their strength in tournaments this season due to the pandemic. But they trained a lot and regularly. We hope that next year will bring them ATP points and higher rankings.

Melissa Boyden

In February, she was a **semifinalist at the J4 Doorn** event. In July 2020, Melissa reached the quarter-final of the **Dutch National Championship** for players under

18 in singles. So she is at the top-8 junior players in the Netherlands in the age group from 16 to 18 years old. She also became the **national champion in doubles**.
