



Scouting & Voting Modules

TokenStars platform creates an efficient system of scouting, funding, and further support of the talented athletes. This article will cover the basic information on how it works and also how to get a reward from the scouting process.

Talent Scouting Module

The talent scouting module implements platform-based interactions between TokenStars, talent scouts, and token holders who have volunteered to become Analysts.

TokenStars decentralizes the talent sourcing process to ensure a high-quality flow of candidates. Unlike traditional agencies with a limited number of in-house scouts, TokenStars creates a Global Scouts Network, encouraging scouts with well-balanced stimuli to bring the most talented players to our platform.

How does it work

1. Any token holder can become a Scout by signing up on the platform's website or in the app. The new scout must be the holder of at least one token to apply.
2. The token holder becomes a scout and gets access to special platform functions that allow him or her to propose new rising talents.
3. Talents pass automatic screening (based on their youth stats and results) and offline assessment conducted by TokenStars licensed scouts, which provides information for the future selection of candidates for voting and contract proposal.
4. Any token holder can register as an Analyst and gain access to the talent's data and to the voting.

5. Analysts can vote for or against signing a contract with the new star candidate. The number of votes equals the number of tokens held by every analyst.
6. TokenStars signs the contract with the future star and confirms it in the system, and this triggers an immediate and automatic transfer of tokens to the recruiter's account.
7. The scout continues his or her work with players and submits periodic analytical reports on their performance.
8. Analysts review the reports and can vote for or against contract renewal with the talent and head of the scouting network, who made the final proposal on signing the contract with the talent.
9. TokenStars renews the contract with the approved talent and approves the completion of the task, and an additional reward is paid to the scout who provided the talent's application to the platform.
10. The recruiter continues his or her work with the stars with periodic reviews by the supervisor and the analysts, receiving automatic payments in tokens after every iteration.
11. TokenStars holds periodic prize draws where the most active analysts have better chances to receive rewards in tokens and other possible prizes.

Voting module


The voting module is used as infrastructure support for other modules. The platform will hold polls among token holders on the significant decisions: one of the most meaningful use cases of voting is in the Scouting section, where fans provide their opinion on approving new players.

This module will be also tightly interconnected with modules from the Fan Community layer, when it will be used as a standalone mechanism for polls


conducted by celebrities. For example, fans might be able to vote on how to celebrate a scored goal.

Up to May 2020, there were 32 voting procedures on the website, 17 votings for poker players, and 15 for tennis juniors. Among these 32, three players were rejected by the community. This rate is low because a part of candidates does not pass the previous step, the experts review.

First scouting results of 2020

The Scouting Module is available for both ACE and TEAM token holders.

In the ACE portfolio, there are three promising tennis players:

- Valeria Olyanovskaya (Russia)
- Jasza Szarjych (Poland)
- Melissa Boyden (the Netherlands)



In January 2020 Valeriya Olyanovskaya won her first PRO tournament. Valeriya won ITF Turkey 03A in a tournament in Antalya. In the final match, she masterfully defeated (6:0;6-2) Silvia Njiric (WTA #610). Jasza and Melissa are playing as juniors, but we are looking forward to celebrating their future victories as pro players.

The TEAM portfolio includes 10 professional poker players from Germany, Italy, Canada, Argentina, and other countries.

In February 2020, Tobias Schaaf and Marco D'Amico participated in the 888poker LIVE Festival Madrid 888€ main event. Tobias scored 82nd place, winning 2 000€ while Marco has reached the final table and achieved the 7th place, winning 24 000€.

We are still working on discovering promising sports stars. Any token holder can become a scout and propose the next Federer or Sharapova join TokenStars. And get a reward from successful applicants!
